Israel's Northern Coastline

- **Caesarea** – We'll explore the remains of King Herod's coastal port, including the famous Roman theatre, the Hippodrome and Herod's seaside palace. All whilst enjoying the view and morning breeze from the Mediterranean Sea
- **Zichron Yaakov** – One of the first modern settlements in Israel, founded in 1882 by Romanian pioneers. Named after Baron Rothschild's father James (Yaakov) in 1883, it became one of the first Jewish agricultural colonies in the Holy land.
- **Haifa – Louis Promenade** – Lookout over Bahai Gardens & Temple & enjoy this spectacular view overlooking the entire Haifa harbour and all the way to the white rocks of the Lebanese border to the north, the Jezreel valley and Kishon river to the east and of course, you can never go wrong looking at the Mediterranean Sea.
- **Akko** – The old city of Akko has always been a strategic and economical port to the Holy land. Here the Crusaders had their capital, Napoleon was defeated and as the British used the Turkish fort as a prison for both Jewish and Arabs during the Mandate period, it was the location of one of the most daring and successful escapes by the underground forces.
- **Rosh Hanikra** – On the northern most point of the Mediterranean coast of Israel, is this natural wonder that spans millennia. We'll take a cable car down to explore the grottos, check out the remains of the British rail built by Anzacs and South Africans and say hi to the Israeli soldiers guarding the coastal border between Lebanon and Israel.
