Golan - Galil

- **Jeep ride through the Golan** – We'll begin our day by going off road to see the lush, 'off the beaten track', sites around the Golan Heights. You'll learn some of the history of the region and get to see the picturesque villages and moshavim nestled amongst the hills and agricultural fields.
- **Mt Bental** – Here we'll climb to over 1100 meters above sea level and stand on top of an extinct volcano. We'll look in to Syria, get the opportunity to explore bunkers from the Yom Kippur war, see Mt Hermon – Israel's tallest mountain, and check out the breathtaking views of pastures, orchids, villages, volcanoes and mountains.
- **De Karina Chocolate Factory** – A tradition of chocolate making, passed on through generations. You'll get to tour the production facility, enjoy tasting the scrumptious treats and take part in a hands-on workshop to make your own chocolates. No trip to the Golan would be complete without a stop here.
- **Dalton Winery – Tour & Tasting** - Nestled in the hills of the Upper Galil (Galilee), Dalton was established in 1995 by Father and son who envisioned the region as an exceptional location to produce wines. They have overwhelmingly succeeded in producing superior wines as well as providing jobs and promoting tourism to the region.
- **Tzfat (Safed)** – One of the four holy cities in Israel, and the birthplace of Kabbalah from the 1600's. Come and explore this mystical city as we meander our way through the streets and alleyways. Enjoy the atmosphere, clean air, great views, Artist colony and experience the magic and beauty that is Tzfat.
