Eilat & the South

- **Sde Boker** – A kibbutz famous for the home and burial site of Israel's first Prime Minister, David Ben Gurion. We'll visit his 'tzrif' (home) and see how the first PM lived modestly and how his dream and vision of making the desert bloom became a reality.
- **Machtesh Ramon – (Ramon Crater)** – The world's largest erosion crater, located in the Negev desert, is also Israel's largest national park. Enjoy amazing views from the top and learn about the area's geology, flora and fauna in the Visitor's center. We'll then continue south as we drive through the 'Machtesh' and hope to see the Ibex's and other shy animals which inhabit the area.
- **Timna National Park** – Site of the world's first copper mines from the time of Ancient Egypt and King Solomon, Timna offers its visitors a chance to step back in time and explore geological, archaeological and natural wonders of the region.
- **Eilat** – Israel's most southern city and the gateway to Asia and Africa via the Red Sea, Eilat has so much to offer everyone. Take the opportunity to relax by the sea or pool, enjoy water sports, restaurants, fair grounds, tax free shopping, hikes through the mountains and canyons, visit the second largest bird sanctuary in Israel and that's just for starters.
